- Improper or erratic traffic lane changes;
- Following the vehicle ahead too closely; or
- A violation, arising in connection with a fatal accident, of State or local law relating to motor vehicle traffic control (other than a parking violation). (Serious traffic violations **do not** include vehicle weight and defect violations.)
