

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PIT-D, NEW MEXICO VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS FORM

Attach Schedule PIT-D, *New Mexico Voluntary Contributions Schedule*, to Form PIT-1 if you wish to donate all, or part, of a refund to one or more of the special funds shown below.

You can make a contribution only when your return shows an overpayment (refund). Your PIT-D contribution(s) may not be more than the overpayment.

NOTE: If you are not due a refund, but wish to contribute to any of the funds, DO NOT send the contributions to the Taxation and Revenue Department. Please send them directly to the appropriate address listed below.

Consider your contributions carefully. They cannot be changed or refunded if you change your mind. **You may not change contributions on an amended return.**

The Taxation and Revenue Department will deduct the contribution from your refund and transfer it to the appropriate fund. On a joint return, both individuals must agree to the contributions.

LINE 1.
Enter the overpayment amount from line 33 of Form PIT-1.

LINE 2.
Share with Wildlife

This program, administered by the New Mexico Game and Fish Department, assists non-game or endangered species. Ninety percent (90%) of donations go directly to benefit wildlife through research, habitat protection, public education and wildlife rehabilitation. **Enter your donation amount on line 2 of Schedule PIT-D.** *Contact: Share with Wildlife, P.O. Box 25112, Santa Fe, NM 87504-5112, or call (505) 476-8111.*

LINE 3.
Veterans' National Cemetery Fund

The New Mexico Department of Veterans' Services administers this fund to increase the size of the Santa Fe National Cemetery. **Enter your contribu-**

tion on line 3 of Schedule PIT-D. The Commission sends contributions, that the Veterans' National Cemetery Fund has received since it began, in excess of \$1,070,000 to the Substance Abuse Education Fund. *Contact: New Mexico Department of Veterans' Services, P.O. LINE 4.
New Mexico Substance Abuse Education Fund

LINE 5.
New Mexico Forest Re-Leaf Program

The Forestry Division of the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department administers this fund through the Conservation Planting Revolving Fund. Donations help a tree-planting grant program for New Mexico communities. **Enter your donation on line 5 of Schedule PIT-D.** *Contact: New Mexico Forestry Division, P.O. LINE 6.
National Guard Member and Family Assistance

Contributions will be distributed to the Department of Military Affairs for assistance to members of the New Mexico National Guard activated for service in the "global war on terrorism" and to their families. **Enter your donation on line 6 of Schedule PIT-D.** *Contact: Department of Military Affairs, P.O. Box 2324, Santa Fe, NM 87504-2324, or call (505) 827-6303.*

LINE 7.
Kids in Parks Education Program

Contributions are for expenditures for the kids in parks education program administered by the State Parks Division of the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department. **Enter your donation on line 7 of Schedule PIT-D.** *Contact: New Mexico State Parks Division, P.O. LINE 8.
Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis Research Fund

The fund is appropriated to the board of regents of the University of New Mexico for amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (Lou Gehrig's disease) research. LINE 9.
New Mexico Political Parties Contribution

You may contribute \$2 to the state political party you choose. If you file a joint return, each spouse may contribute \$2 to a party. **Enter the number designation of the state political party to which you choose to make a donation.**

LINE 10.
Total of Voluntary Fund Contributions

Add lines 2 through 9. Enter total on line 34 of Form PIT-1.

NOTE: If contribution(s) exceed the refund due, NO contribution(s) will be deducted.

You can make voluntary contributions only if your return shows an overpayment.
